Independence and Integration

Equipment and Independence

*Indicates subjects for the one day training course only. For the full course to be delivered, two days are necessary.

The course will be delivered by people with direct experience of disability, within a non-threatening, confidential and safe environment. The one or two day courses can also be delivered in house for organisations according to need.

SYCIL's DET is National Open College Network accredited to level 2 or 3 and learners wanting to gain accreditation can be accommodated alongside those who just wish to do the course. SYCIL will also issue its own certificate of attendance to all learners.
